SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM CRITERIA AND APPLICATION

A) Intent of the Program

The Concrete Contractors Association of Greater Chicago Scholarship Program is established to provide scholarship funds to individuals continuing their education. The following describes the criteria the applicant must follow to be eligible to receive funds.

B) Available Scholarship Funds

- 1) A \$ 1,000.00 “cap” amount will be provided to each recipient per annum
- 2) Monies will be paid to the school or seminar directly.
- 3) Monies distributed are subject to the availability of funds
- 4) Each member may have only 2 applications per year.

C) Eligibility Requirements

1) Fully paid members in good standing, their immediate families and their employees are eligible. Those who can prove need (i.e. hardship) or have financial hardship will be given priority.

D) Approved Schools and Programs

- 1) Construction related classes and programs.
- 2) Classes that further the recipient in his/her construction related field.
- 3) College classes that go for an approved degree.
- 4) Seminars, builders’ institutes and review classes as reviewed by the committee will be accepted on a case by case basis.

E) Applicants

1) Original applications must be obtained from the Concrete Contractors Association of Greater Chicago office. The application must be **completely** filled out and the original application be submitted to the office per the published dates **prior** to the school year requested and receive prior approval to be eligible.

2) The applicant must have a letter of recommendation from a CCA member in good standing who will sponsor the applicant attached to the application. Facsimile copies are not acceptable.

3) The CCA member (in good standing) must be a member for at least one **FULL** year prior to the Application being submitted.

4) Any application submitted must be the stamped original, typed and signed by the applicant in addition to the signature of the sponsor prior to review by the scholarship committee. A rejection or reduction of the applicant’s request possibly will be lowered if the form is handwritten or illegible. **Facsimile or a photocopy application will not be accepted.**



E) Applicants

5) The application must be dropped off or sent to the Concrete Contractors Association Office within the time line of the published dates to:

6) Applications will be available from, January 2nd to July 15th at the Concrete Contractors Association of Greater Chicago office. These dates may vary from year to year and will be as published.

7) The completed applications must be received in the CCA office no later than July 31st to become eligible for review.

F) Accepted College Courses should have the following:

1) Courses must be taken for a letter grade and not as an audit. A copy of the high school grade transcript should be submitted with the scholarship application from a high school student. (See F.3 for exception).

2) Courses that are considered to be relevant to the construction industry or pertinent to the applicant's role in his/her construction firm.

3) Seminars will be reviewed on a case by case basis and line F.1 will apply as the committee sees fit.

4) Examples of the courses considered acceptable are as follows:

i. Field courses may be: Construction Technology, Blueprint Reading, Estimating, Project Management, etc.

ii. Management courses may be: Accounting, Computer data Processing, Business Law, Finance, etc.
